Title of the Plan:

Draft Elmbridge Local Plan 2022-2037.

Subject matter and area covered by the plan:

Elmbridge Borough Council has published the draft local plan that it intends to submit to the Secretary of State for independent examination. The draft Local Plan will cover the whole of the administrative area of Elmbridge Borough and includes a wide range of planning policies. The draft Local Plan sets out a vision, objectives and spatial strategy to 2037 and allocates sites that are needed to accommodate new development and areas to be protected and enhanced. The policies in the draft Plan will be used to make decisions on planning applications. The monitoring framework sets out how the draft Plan will be monitored.

Period for making representations:

Representations are invited on the draft Local Plan for a period of six weeks beginning at 9am on Friday 17 June 2022 and ending at 4pm on Friday 29 July 2022.

- Submission of the Local Plan to the Secretary of State for independent examination under Section 20 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004
- Publication of the recommendations of the Planning Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State to carry out the independent examination
- Adoption of the Local Plan by the Council
- Future revisions to the Local Plan, new planning policies and guidance.
